Cable Community Panel Fact Sheet

Mission and Purpose

The volunteer panel's principal focus is to enhance Civic Center TV's multi-media programming efforts and to increase community engagement with and awareness of those efforts.

This panel is created for the purpose of working with the Community Programming Committee of the Greater West Bloomfield Cable Communications Commission (GWBCCC) in seeking information regarding the needs, concerns, and interests of residents and recommending programming that may be created to fulfill this goal. The panel may assist in the evaluation and improvement of such programming.

Panel Members

Appointed members are eight to ten residents representing a cross section from within the communities of Keego Harbor, Orchard Lake, Sylvan Lake, and West Bloomfield. Panel members are asked to serve actively for one year with an option to renew.

Meetings

The Panel meets in the Green Media Center quarterly to discuss pertinent issues related to the mission and purpose of the Panel.

In preparation for each meeting, members are provided an agenda in advance, prepared by the Community Programming Committee, which includes issues to be discussed and links to multi-media segments for evaluation.
