Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980 as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except:

1. One and two family dwellings containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
2. Alteration and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature.
3. Assembly, Business, mercantile, and storage building with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12.
4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00

PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

V. Home Owner Affidavit

I hereby certify the plumbing work described on this permit application shall be installed by myself in my own home in which I am living or about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the Plumbing Code and shall not be enclosed, covered up, or put into operation until it has been inspected and approved by the City Plumbing Inspector. IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the City of Orchard Lake Village. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The Telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the City of Orchard Lake Village with 24 (twenty four) hour notice. The inspector will need the job location and the permit number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED. NOTE: APPLICATION FEE NON-REFUNDABLE.
